- Additional partnership work has focused on supporting the reengagement of the City's Black Male Opportunity Youth with the MPS Office of Black and Latino Male Achievement

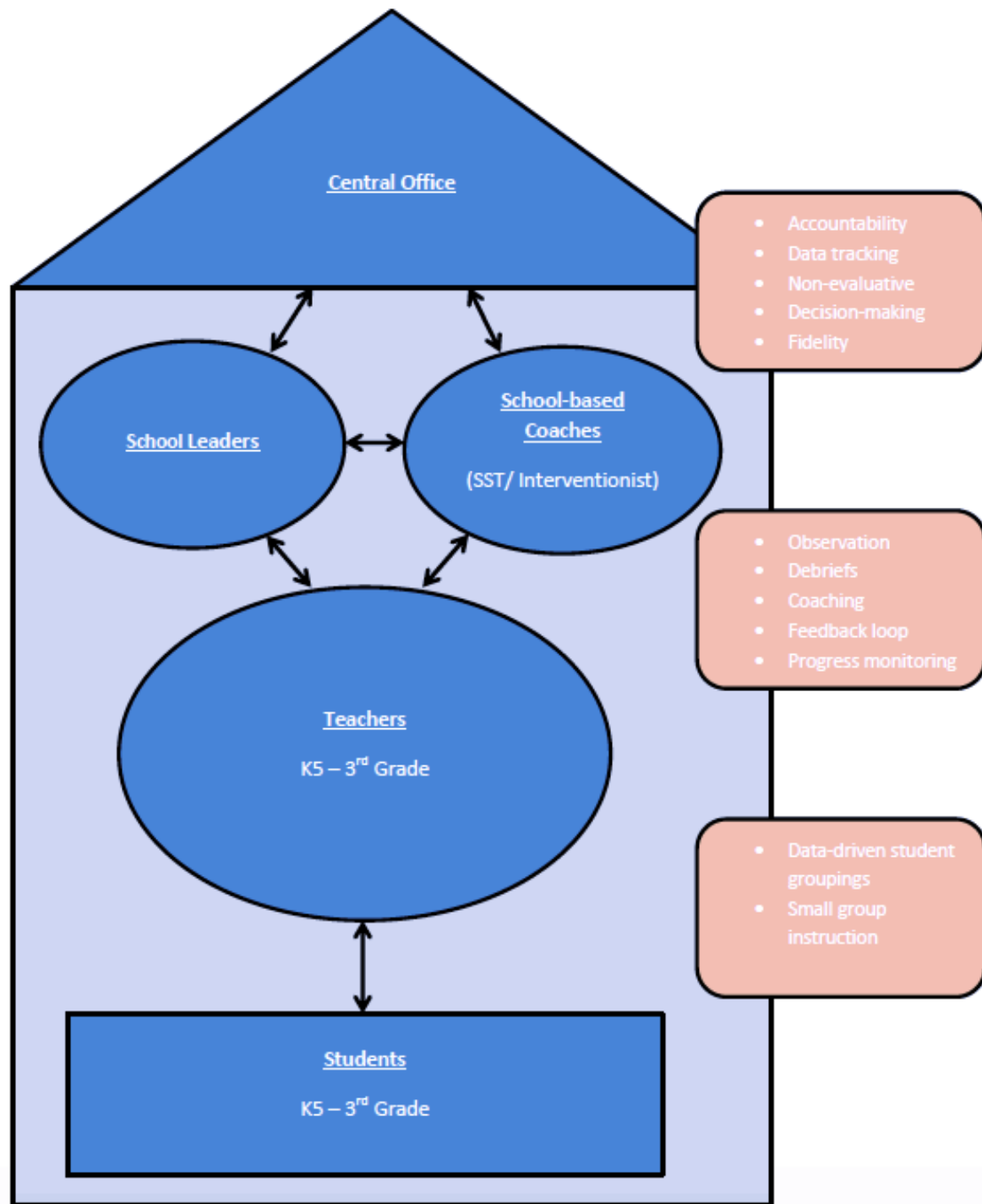
Reading Foundations

- Student Tutoring

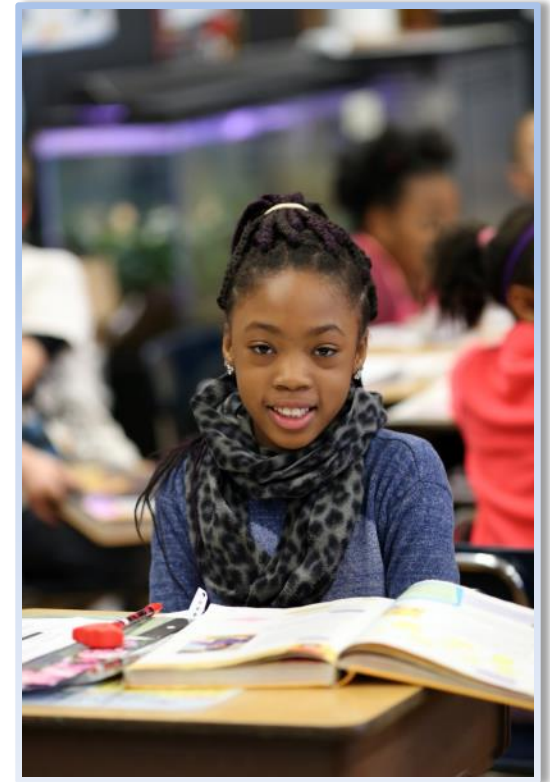


TRI Program Framework
