- The MKE Fellows initiative was created to encourage young men from Milwaukee to complete their college education & return home as successful professionals.
- Created initially as Morehouse partnership in 2012.
- Group raised nearly \$900,000 to send students to Morehouse College. 7 students were MPS students.
- In 2014 the initiative grew to include other universities/colleges throughout the country.

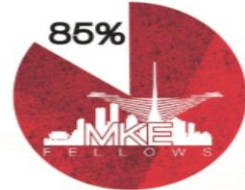

MKE FELLOWS BY THE NUMBERS



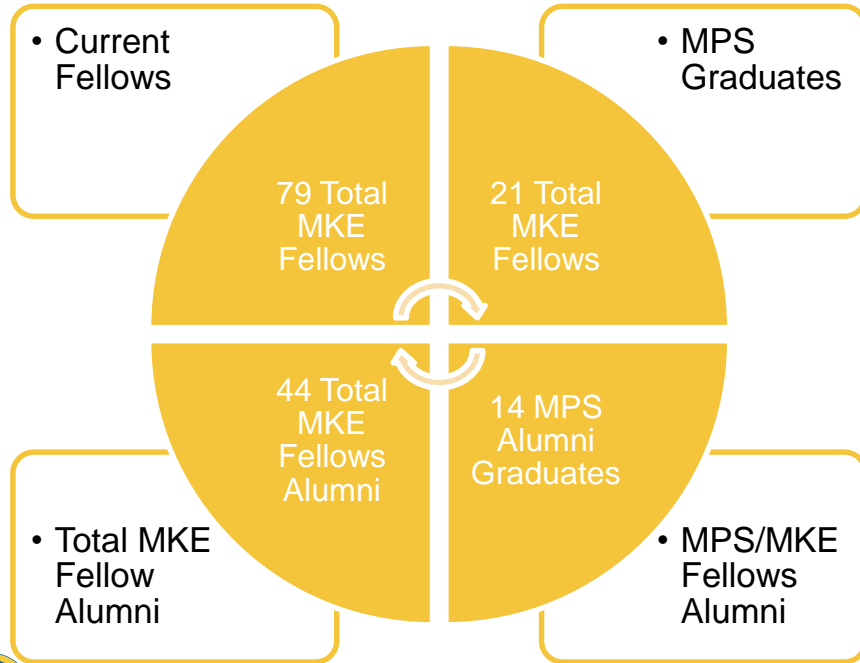
