American Board for Certification of Teacher Excellence

Find out how you can become a teacher without going back to college through this self-paced, self-study program.

CESA #1

Proficiency Based Licensure is a certification program for individuals interested in obtaining Wisconsin initial teacher certification. The program provides teacher candidates with the resources and support necessary to achieve proficiency in the ten Wisconsin Standards for Teacher Development and Licensure. CESA also provides a route for currently licensed teachers to expand their certification.



CARDINAL STRITCH UNIVERSITY

Learn about the New Teacher Pipeline, a licensure program specifically designed to meet the needs of the returning adult student or a master's degree in elementary, middle, or high school education.

Permit Teacher PMAC

Permit teachers can earn a degree and/or teaching certification through Cardinal Stritch University. Eligible candidates include interns with a commitment to urban education who teach in hard-to-fill positions.

WISCONSIN LUTHERAN COLLEGE

This licensure program specializes in high-performance instruction, leadership and innovation, instructional technology, special education leadership, crosscategorical special education, and transitions to new careers in teaching. Also offered is a master's degree in teaching.



tec Milwaukee Teacher Education Center

Find out about this 15-18 month program focusing on special education and high-need areas offered in collaboration with Mount Mary University. MTEC offers mentors and training. Also offered are add-on and extended certification pathways.

Reading Teacher License Program

This program allows candidates to earn Mount Mary a teaching degree or certification through Mount Mary University. It can be combined with the Master of Arts in Education program.

TEACHFORAMERICA

This two-year certification program provides mentors and support and is designed to provide excellent leaders for our community, our schools, our classrooms, and bevond.



University Of Wisconsin-Whitewater

This online program specializes in special education and early education.

Other Programs

Paraprofessional-to-Teacher Pathway

Current paraprofessionals in MPS for a minimum of 2 years are eligible, and must make a commitment to MPS for 3 years after completion of teaching degree.

PLUS Program partnership with MATC and UWM

This program allows adults with MA**TC** bachelor's degrees to begin teaching in MPS while earning certification. Candidates are teachers-of-record in MPS schools, working under a Wisconsin teaching permit. During the program, participants have full teaching responsibilities.

UWM Pre-intern Program

Candidates are employed as paraprofessionals in MPS. This program is designed for individuals without certification. Interns take on full teaching responsibilities in the second year and receive a beginning teacher salary with benefits.

Alverno College

Designed for college graduates seeking teaching licensure and for teachers who want to upgrade their skills, renew their licensure or extend it to new areas, using undergraduate coursework.
