WI Dept of Trans	Safe Routes to Schools (C&I)	328,800	This grant supports continuation of bicycle safety and awareness programs across the district.
Milw Metro Sewerage Dist	Green Infrastructure Partnership Program (FMS)	21,245	This grant will support improvements identified in the Milwaukee Recreation's Master Plan for Columbia, Custer and Southgate Playfields.
US Off Adm Chldrn Fam	Head Start COLA (C&I)	222,607	This grant will support the cost of living increase required for Head Start program. Funds support personnel and fringe benefit costs of the program.
Wisconsin DPI	WI DPI Refugee Impact Grant (C&I)	11,500	This grant provides continued support for the refugee student population by creating welcome teams at schools with high refugee student populations. The district continues to enroll increasing numbers of immigrant and refugee students with low level English and/or native language skills, and often limited formal schooling in their native countries.
US Dept of Education	US Dept of Ed Arts Assistance (C&I)	2,500,000	The AIMing for Quality Arts and Achievement project will focus on serving and addressing the academic needs of disadvantaged students through high quality arts instruction and arts integration. The project is designed to effectively (1) increasing access to high-quality, standards-based arts education; (2) integrating standards-based arts education into other subjects; and (3) improving students academic performance.
Wisconsin DPI	WI DPI Open Educational Resources (C&I Algebra)	10,000	The district will recruit and develop a team of current teachers involved in Algebra programming. The team of teachers will collaboratively create a bank of lesson plans and projects to be used by teachers in MPS and state-wide. In addition, the team of teachers will create modules designed to support successful classroom implementation in the new content areas. These modules will be uploaded to the district learning management system and WISELearn.
WI Dept Workforce Dev	WI DWD Fast Forward Teacher Training Grant	50,000	This grant supports the pipeline of special education teacher certification for paraprofessionals who have not completed their bachelor's degree. This program is a collaborative effort between MPS, Milwaukee Area Technical College and the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee.
