SUMMARY REPORT: DISTRICT SAFETY DRILL

As of October 27, 2021 all Milwaukee Public Schools conducted a safety drill. This was done as required by WI. State Statute 118.07(4)(cp) and is applicable to all schools, public or private, in Wisconsin. The drills consisted of a standard code red or code yellow response.

A written evaluation is to be prepared by each schools' administrator and will be provided to the school board. The school board is to review the drills' evaluations within 30 days of the drill. The school board is to then provide a certification of the drills that will be forwarded to the WI. Department of Justice Office of School Safety prior to January 1st, 2022.

The drills are meant to provide training in the event a code red or yellow response is necessary. Schools utilize the district and schools' safety plan. Issues of concern are addressed at the school level with staff. Drills can last anywhere from a few minutes to several minutes depending on various factors including the size of the school and prior preparations.

The drills were completed appropriately rendering discussions at the school level as to what needs improvement.
