

Report of the Board's Delegate to Cooperative Educational Service Agency #1 (CESA #1)

CESA #1 BOARD OF CONTROL MEETING TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 21, 2017

- (1) A review of the audit took place. The auditor reported that everything appears to be in order.
- (2) The 2017-18 budget proposal was approved.
- (3) CESA #1 has revised its website (<http://www.cesa1.k12.wi.us/>). The site now includes much more information on individualized learning. Everyone is encouraged to take a look.
- (3) A report was given on the 8th Annual National Convening on Personalized Learning , which was held right here in Milwaukee on October 13 through November 1, 2017. More than 500 individuals attended: 1/3 from the Milwaukee area, 1/3 from around the state, and 1/3 from out of state. CESA #1 is a leader in individualized learning.
- (4) Ryan Krohn from the CESA # 1 will be participating in a national study on individualized learning to be conducted by the Rand Corporation. A previous Rand study questioned the effectiveness of individualized learning, but the problem may be in the implementation of the program, rather than in the concept itself.
