MIAD is responsible for: - Meeting regularly with Milwaukee Recreation to develop and execute the program. - Recruiting, hiring, and paying selected artists-in-residence. - Providing meeting space for the information and kick-off meetings, to include projection capabilities and seating for up to 30 people. - Providing catering for meetings, as needed.
