Target Corp	Target Field Trip - Fairview	600	The Cathedral Center provides emergency shelter and case management services for women and families. I think it is important that my students learn about community involvement and service. Students will be required to plan and execute the entire field trip themselves. Students will prepare approximately 150 bag lunches per class (2 classes) and deliver them to the shelter. Students will tour the shelter, learn about how/why people become homeless and what kinds of help and opportunities are available to them.
PLACEHOLDER	Milwaukee Public Museum (Kluge)	400	This project will fund admission for students and staff to participate in a Early Learning Field Trip. As a result of this field trip experience, students will develop a deeper understanding of the interconnectedness of living things and their needs.
Wisconsin DPI	WI DPI - Refugee School Impact Grant	24,000	The Division of Bilingual Multicultural Education will use this funding source in three ways Adult ESL courses, Collaboration with parent coordinators, and materials for new programming during high school summer school.
WisItalia	WisItalia (Wedgewood)	250	WisItalia is dedicated to promoting the teaching of the Italian language and culture in Wisconsin K-12 and post-secondary schools. This grant will help fund costs related to Wedgewood's teaching of Italian.
