Meemic Foundation	Meemic Back to School (Holmes)	100	This grant will fund school supplies for students.
Target Corp	Target Field Trip (Green Bay)	700	This grant will help fund a field trip to Discovery World to enhance students' science and social studies education.
Target Corp	Target Field Trip (Hawthorne)	700	This grant will help fund a field trip to a site that aligns with the school's math, science, and literacy standards such as Hawthorne Glen, Milwaukee Art Museum, or the Milwaukee Public Library.
Milwaukee Public	Early Learning Field Trip (Fairview)	500	This grant will fund a field trip to the Milwaukee Public Museum for K4 students to participate in the butterfly garden, which aligns with Frog Street curriculum.
Wisconsin DPI	Community Learning Centers (Rec)	1,735,000	21st Century Community Learning Centers are programs designed to provide students with academic support, enrichment, and youth development opportunities in an after school setting. The current cohort of DPI funding proposals includes requests from 16 sites, ranging from K-8 locations to high schools. Records project the funding request at \$2,125,000 and approximately 3,500 students throughout the city of Milwaukee are projected to participate in programming at these sites.
US Off Adm Chldrn Fam	Head Start (C&I)	8,597,310	Milwaukee Public Schools Head Start Program is dedicated to enhancing the cognitive, social, emotional and physical well-being of children and families in Milwaukee. The agency provides quality educational programs for preschool children, as well as supportive family services in partnership with parents and their communities. Federal Head Start funds provide support for 1,370 K3 and K4 seats.
Anthem	Watch Us Sprout Garden Grant (German Immersion)	500	This grant will fund a school garden in the underutilized school courtyard.
Anthem	Watch Us Sprout Garden Grant (Clement)	500	This grant will fund the upkeep of the school's existing garden.
US Dept of Education	EASIE	103,751	The EASIE grant supports local educational agencies (LEAs) in their efforts to reform elementary and secondary school programs that serve First Nations students. Programs are to be based on challenging state content and student performance standards used for all students and are designed to assist First Nations students to meet those standards through cultural and academic programming.
