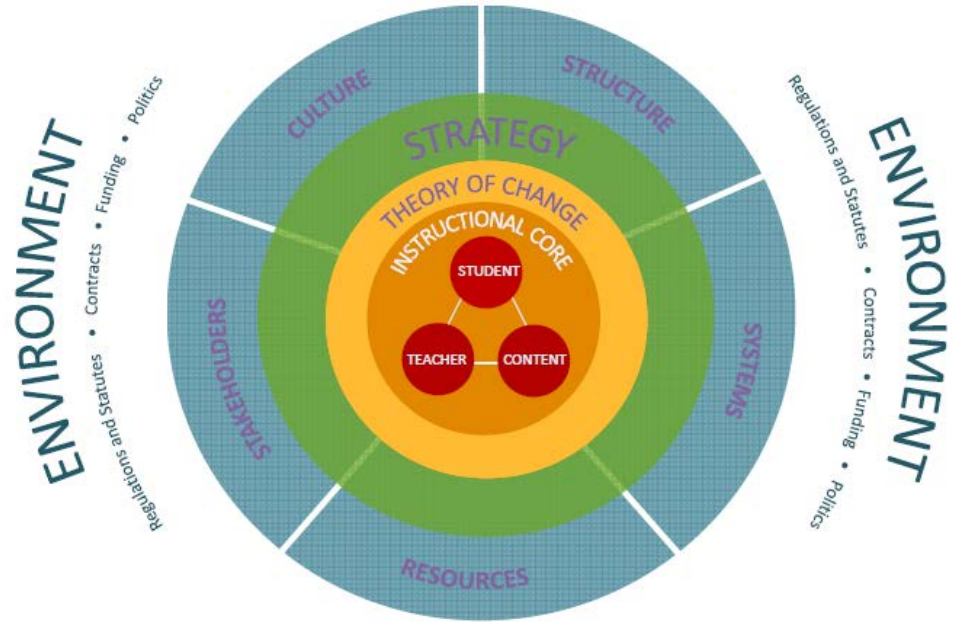

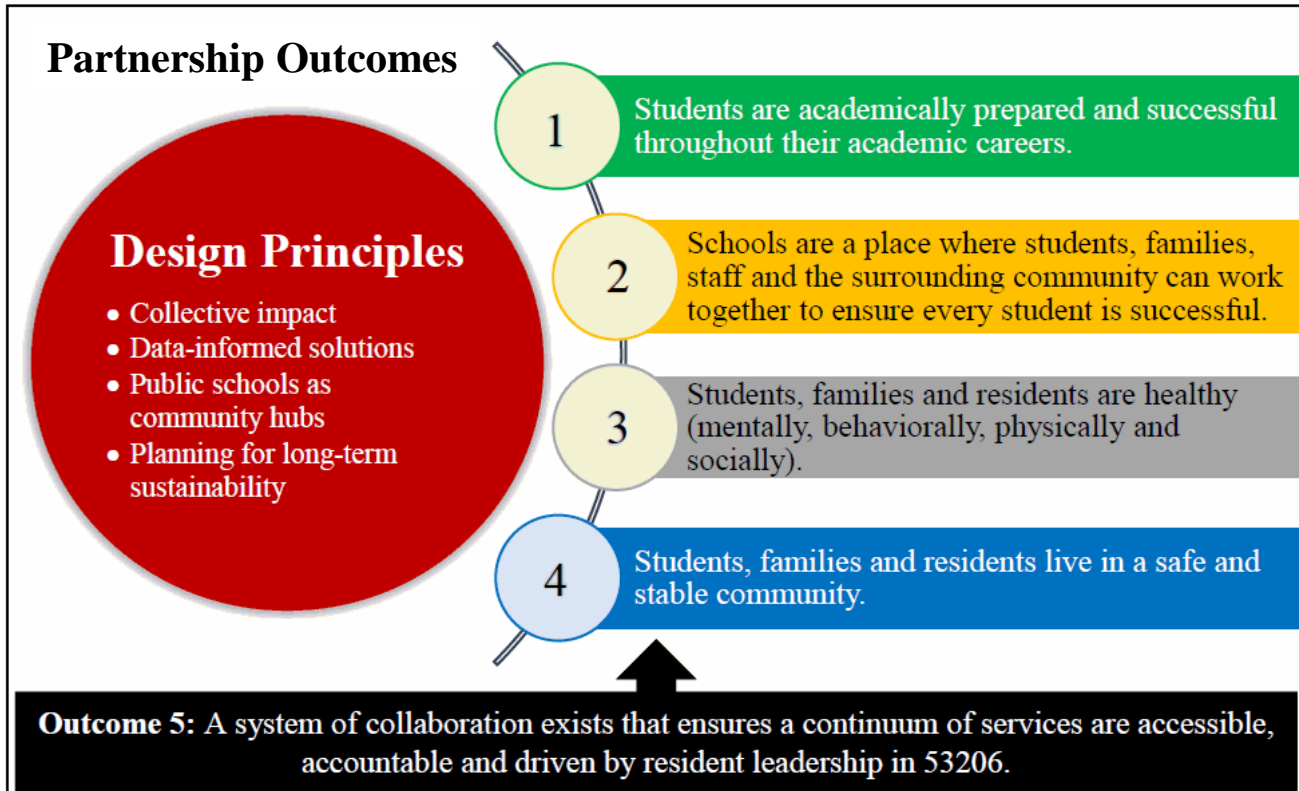

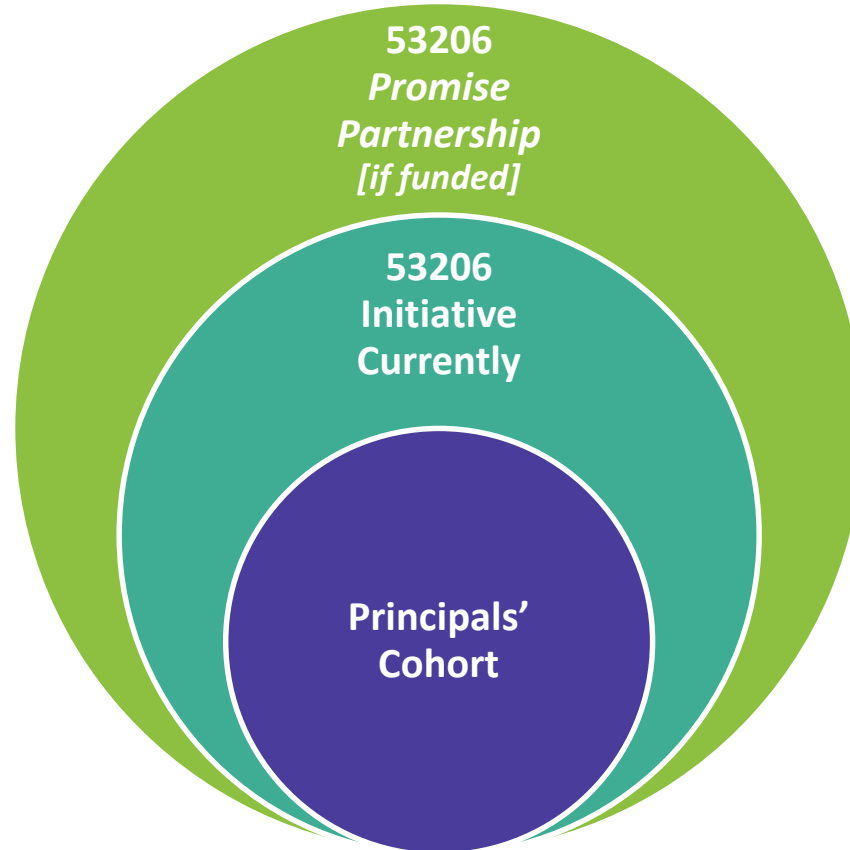
VISION
