Administration Response:

The following salary schedules have been drafted with current best cost estimates including benefits to implement beginning with the 2019–20 school year:

• Teachers: \$22,042,237

Educational assistants: \$2,607,794Speech pathologists: \$1,826,485

Nurses: \$147,461Interpreters: \$269,652

Building service helpers I: \$1,113,570
Building service helpers II: \$243,990
School psychologists: \$482,017

The administration is working to create salary schedules for all classifications.

The salary schedules will have financial impacts going forward. In 2023-24 State integration aid will be eliminated with a net result of an estimated reduction of \$20 million to the district projected revenue.

The fiscal impact to implement the salary schedule beginning with paraprofessionals starting with the 2019–20 school year will be approximately \$2,607,794.
