



- Shared and discussed Resolution with school administration 9/27/18
- Reviewed resolution with Steering Committee 10/24/18
- Marketed for ninth grade at the following:
 - ✓ Middle and High School selection Fair
 - ✓ Parent teacher conferences
 - ✓ Open House

Next Steps

- Solicit support from the Office of Communications
- Develop strategic marketing plan
- Work with Student Services on enrollment
- Ensure Webster is included in the Enrollment Booklet
- Design ninth grade Programming
- Work with HR to secure teachers.

- Determined selection process 9/20/18
- Sent a correspondence to various stakeholders 9/27/18
- Followed up on the correspondence with phone calls 10/10/18
- Developed meeting protocol 10/23/18
- First meeting held 10/24/18
- Eleven members attended 10/24/18

Next Steps

- Analyze research on Prep Schools
