




Diversity is our greatest strength – Early Childhood

MPS Demographics 2019-20


- 12,879 Students

• Ethnicity






PALS Spring Data

Countdown to Kindergarten A Guide for Families



Milwaukee Public Schools wants every child to succeed! Use this step-by-step guide to help your child be ready for the first day of kindergarten.

May to August, 2020





February 1 to March 1, 2020

Download the MPS App to learn more about Milwaukee Public Schools, Visit MPS schools and choose a school for your child. Enroll online, at an MPS school, or at MPS Central Services.



Head Start students: Enroll at the Grant Gordon Learning Center (formerly Lee Learning Center).

K3 and Head Start: Limited programs are available at some MPS schools. Children must turn 3 by September 1 to be eligible.

K4 and Head Start: Programs are available at most schools across the district. Children must turn 4 by September 1 to be eligible.

K5: Programs are available at most schools across the district. Children must turn 5 by

March and April, 2020

Families who enroll by March 1 should receive a letter with their child's school assignment by the end of March. Contact your child's school to schedule a tour so your child can get excited about starting school in fall!


Attend the citywide Kindergarten Kickoff to receive free resources and prizes. Meet other families and kindergarten students. Information will be posted on the MPS website.
