Bay View Nghbrhd Assoc	Bay View Neighborhood Association School Grants Initiative	2,000	Grant funds will be used to install additional water bottle filling stations on the ground and second floors at Bay View High School.
Wisconsin DPI	WI DPI Fresh Fruits and Vegetables (Nutrition)	260,296	Grant funds will allow participating schools to provide their students and classroom teachers with a free fresh fruit or vegetable snack, accompanied by a brief nutrition lesson, two days per week.
Wisconsin DPI	School-based Mental Health Grant (Specialized Services)	75,000	Grant funds will be used to support professional services contracts with community mental health providers that allows MPS to expand and enhance the work of School Community Partnership for Mental Health, which brings mental health services into schools at all tiers of support. There will be increased coordination of services between school-based and community-based mental health systems.
Community Oriented Policing Services	COPS - School Violence Prevention Program	499,835	Grant funds will be used to upgrade 1,800 two-way radios for schools which will allow for improved communication.
Dollar General	Dollar General Youth Literacy (Westside Academy)	3,000	Grant funds will be used to purchase new technology to support literacy initiatives, books, and software for literacy at Westside Academy. Chromebooks will be purchased for the K5-5th grade students to access supplemental reading programs that help improve reading skills.

Eight head start sites and staff will be impacted by these funds.
