

(ATTACHMENT 1) ACTION ON THE AWARD OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACTS

This item initiated by the Administration.

ADMINISTRATION'S RECOMMENDATION

The Administration recommends that the Board approve the following professional services contracts:

RFP 935 Authorization to Extend an Agreement with Catapult Learning West, LLC, and Owners Group d/b/a Learning Exchange for Title IA Services for Non-Public School Students, Title IIA Professional Development Services for Non-Public School Personnel, Title IIIA Services for Non-public School Students who are English Learners and Title IVA Services for Private School Personnel and Supplemental Student Support

The Administration is requesting authorization to extend a contract with Catapult Learning West, LLC and Owners Group d/b/a Learning Exchange for Title IA, Title IIA, and Title IIIA services.

MPS is required by federal legislation to provide equitable Title IA services to eligible Milwaukee-resident students in non-public schools, Title IIA professional development services for non-public school personnel and Title IIIA services to eligible non-public school students who are English learners. Services include supplemental instruction for students at risk of failing and/or who are English learners, and professional development for educational staff and parental involvement activities.

These vendors were chosen pursuant to RFP 935. The contracts may be extended for two additional one-year terms in consideration of achieving performance metrics codified in the contracts and as approved by the Milwaukee Board of School Directors.

These first contract extensions will run from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019.

The contract amounts are based on estimated budget amounts, using a formula determined by federal law and the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction's guidance. The contracted amount for non-public school services is not to exceed \$20,676,005.08 and is available through the following budget codes for the following third-party providers:

RFP 956 Authorization to Extend a Contract with Growing Minds, Inc., Pure Edge, Inc., and Reset-Mindbody, LLC for Mindfulness Programming

The Administration is requesting authorization to enter into contracts with Growing Minds, Inc. (“GM”), Pure Edge, Inc. (“PE”), and Reset-Mindbody (“Reset”), LLC for mindfulness programming services. These vendors will be used to deliver mindfulness services for staff and students to support calm and caring classrooms that will strengthen the integrity of all interventions, equipping students and staff for professional and academic success. Specifically, the services provided will be as follows:

Mindfulness can be defined as the purposeful awareness of thoughts, emotions, physical

feelings, and environment in the present moment, without judgement. There is a variety of research to support that mindfulness in the classroom improves student academic performance and reduces behavioral referrals; however, for mindfulness to be effective, it must be practiced with integrity by school-based staff first. For this reason, the Administration is proposing a district-wide approach to mindfulness services that support both students and staff in a multi-phased, multi-year approach that will best prepare all parties for long-term success.

More than twenty MPS schools have pursued mindfulness services on their own prior to this district-wide RFP with outstanding results that demonstrate a reduction in behavioral referrals and more on-task behavior in the classroom. The proposed contracts are the result of careful consideration and evaluation around the positive impact mindfulness has already had in MPS schools, as well as the potential of Mindfulness. Mindfulness has often been described as the practice that allows all other interventions to work. To practice mindfulness is not an additional expectation on staff, but rather an integrated support of trauma sensitive practice, blended into the multi-tiered system of supports designed to help the district educate the whole child and maintain a highly effective workforce.

The contractors were chosen pursuant to RFP 956, which closed on June 15, 2017. The contracts will run from August 1, 2018 through July 31, 2019 (Year 2), with one additional one-year option to extend if certain performance metrics codified in the contracts are met.

The total cost of the Growing Minds contract in Year 2 will not exceed \$45,000. The total cost of the Reset-Mindbody contract in Year 2 will not exceed \$150,000. No additional funds will be required for the Pure Edge contract in Year 2.

RFP 979 Authorization to Contract with MJ Care, Inc., for Occupational Therapy Services

The Administration requests authorization to contract with MJ Care, Inc. (“MJ Care”) for occupational therapy (“OT”) services as required by Individual Education Plans (“IEPs”) when staff vacancies exist or for long-term employee leave.

While MPS is currently fully staffed for occupational therapy positions, it is projected that two FTE staff members will be utilizing 6-12 weeks of FMLA beginning in the 2018-2019 school year, making it necessary to contract for services. Services to be provided by occupational therapists include direct therapy intervention, development of IEPs, participation in IEP-team meetings, consultation with teachers and support staff and documentation for Medicaid billing.

Contractor was chosen pursuant to RFP 979 which closed on May 1, 2018. The contract will run from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019, (the “Initial Term”), with two additional one-year options to extend if certain performance metrics incorporated into the contract are met.

The total cost of the contract in the Initial Term will not exceed \$75,000.

The Administration is requesting authorization to enter into a contract with Renaissance

Learning, Inc. (“Renaissance”) for STAR 360 universal screening for students in K5-12 (optional K4). Renaissance provides assessments in early literacy, reading and math. Norm-referenced assessments are available in English for early literacy, reading and math. User-norm assessments are available in Spanish (grades K-8) for early literacy, reading and math. MPS will be part of a pilot/field test for grades 9-12 Spanish, reading and math. All STAR 360 assessments are aligned to the Common Core State Standards. STAR 360 may also be utilized as a progress monitoring tool for students in Tier 2 interventions at no additional cost. Additionally, Renaissance will provide customer support and up to 20 professional development hours.

Contractor was chosen pursuant to RFP 982, which closed on May 8, 2018. The contract will run from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019, (the “Initial Term”), with two additional one-year options to extend if certain performance metrics incorporated into the contract are met.

RFB 5735 Authorization to Extend Contracts with Seven Contractors for Field Trip Transportation Services

The Administration is requesting authorization to enter into contracts with Achieve3000, Inc., Curriculum Associates, LLC, Edgenuity Inc., Imagination Station, Learning A-Z, LLC, McGraw-Hill School Education LLC, MIND Research Institute, Pearson Education, Inc. and Santillana USA Publishing Co., Inc., for Tier 2 and Tier 3 Interventions.

The following computer-based interventions are being purchased as Tier 2 and Tier 3 academic supports to meet requirements of Response to Intervention (“Rtl”). The purchase of these software meets the district’s need to meet the Every Student Succeeds Act (“ESSA”) for evidence and/or research based interventions, to align with WI DPI’s vision for Rtl, and to support DPI special education corrective action compliance. The software allows students, families, teachers, school administrators, and district administrators to monitor individual student and school use and progress within the software. Interventions are based online and are available for students to access during the school’s identified intervention time, as well as at home, in after school programs, or other settings.

The interventions are all research based interventions, used by a variety of school districts across the country, in a wide range of settings in kindergarten through 12th grade. The interventions provide additional support to identified students performing below target in the area of math and reading in kindergarten through 12th grade. Use of the intervention with individualized instruction and activities for students based on their individual needs will provide additional support to close academic achievement gaps.

The contractors were chosen pursuant to RFP 975, which closed on February 28, 2018. The contracts will run from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019, (the “Initial Term”), with two additional one-year options to extend if certain performance metrics incorporated into the contract are met.

The total cost of these contracts in this first year will not exceed \$2,599,866 as follows:
