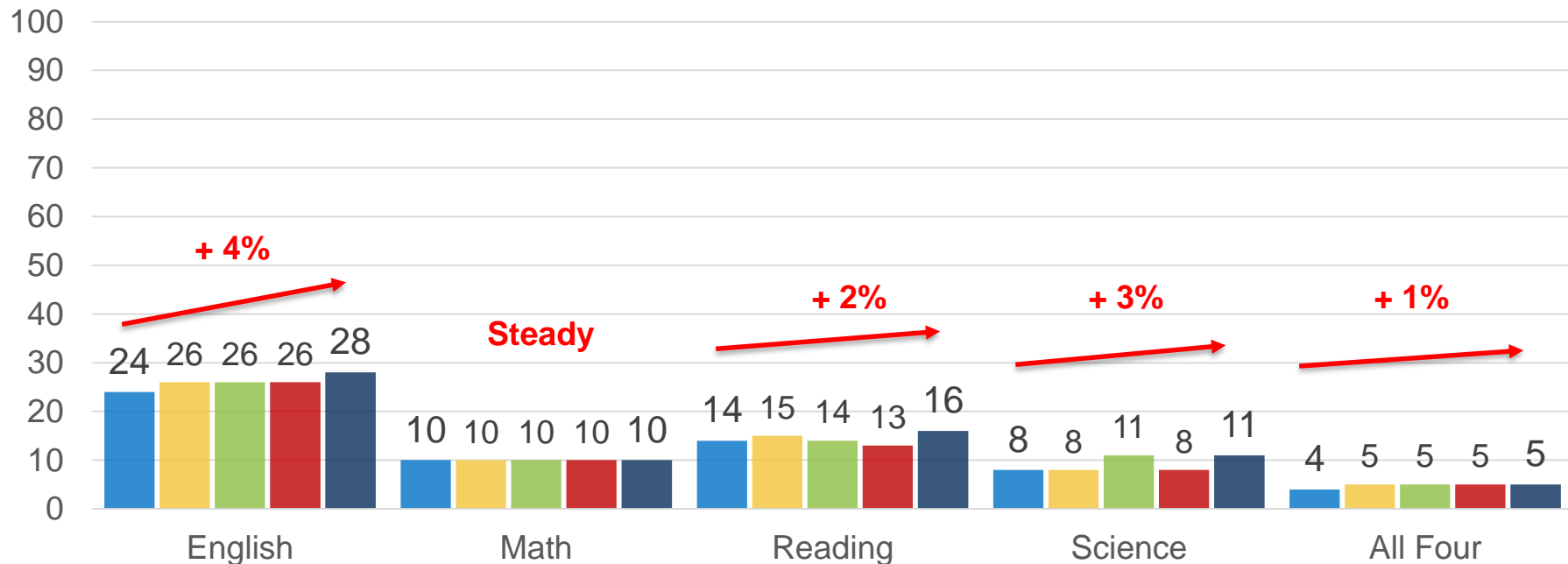
ACT Graduate Data 2017

- All Milwaukee Public School students have been taking ACT in their junior year since 2008, therefore we are able to look at our progress longitudinally.

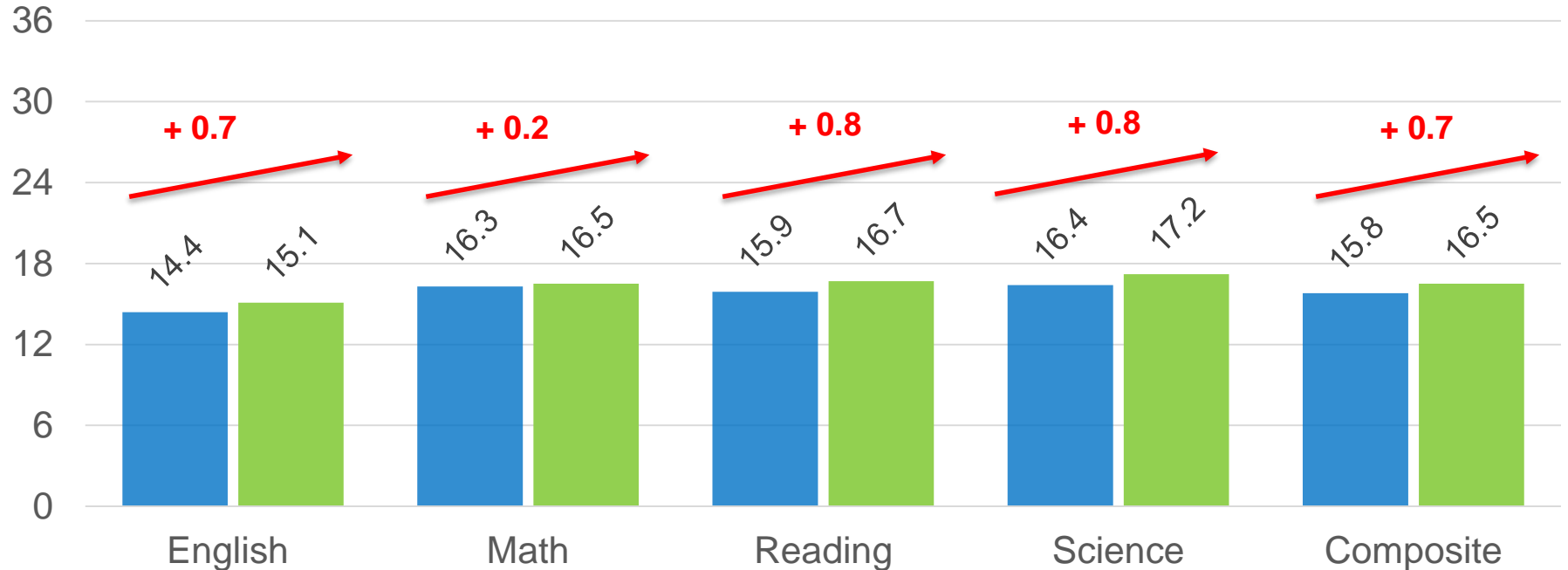
ACT Graduate Data 2017

- This presentation highlights our gains and growth over the past five years

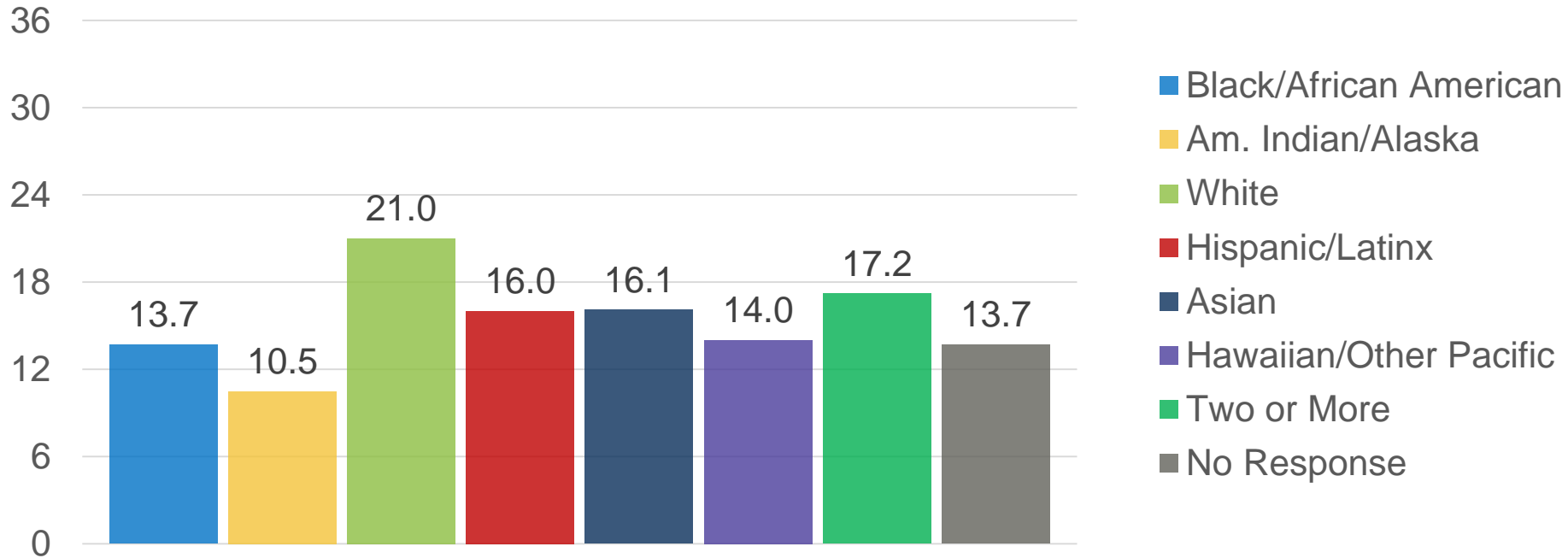
District: ACT Percent College Ready 2013-2017



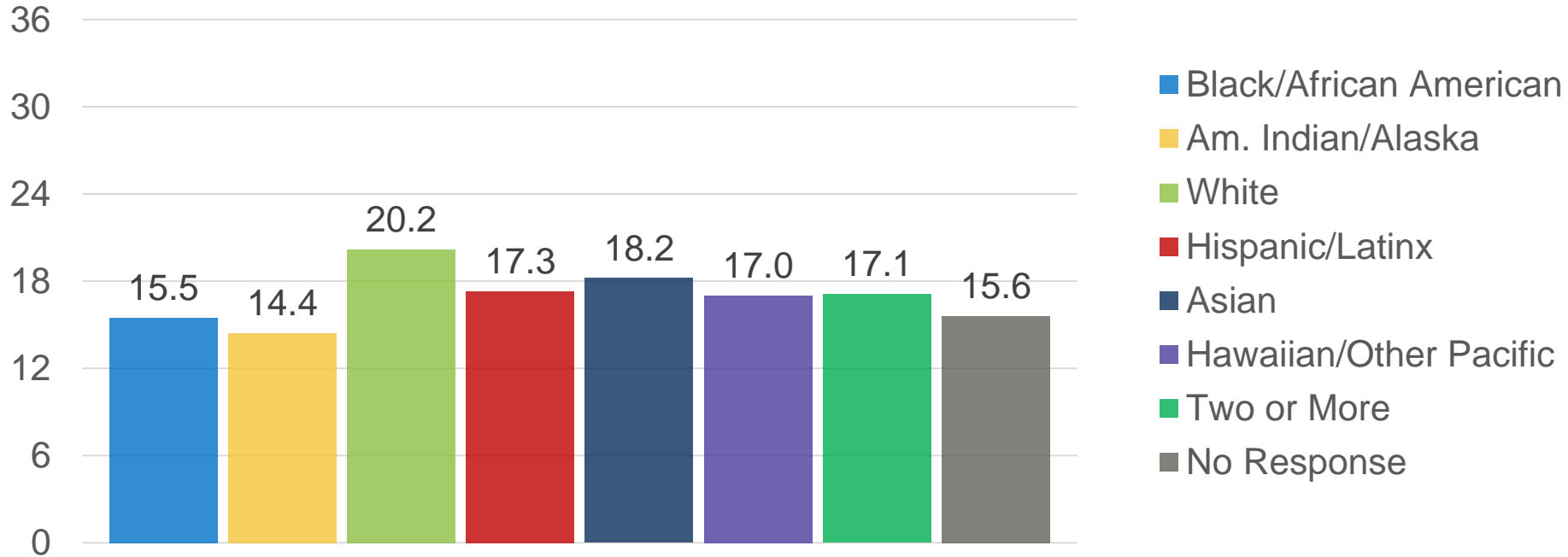
District: ACT Average Scores 2013-2017



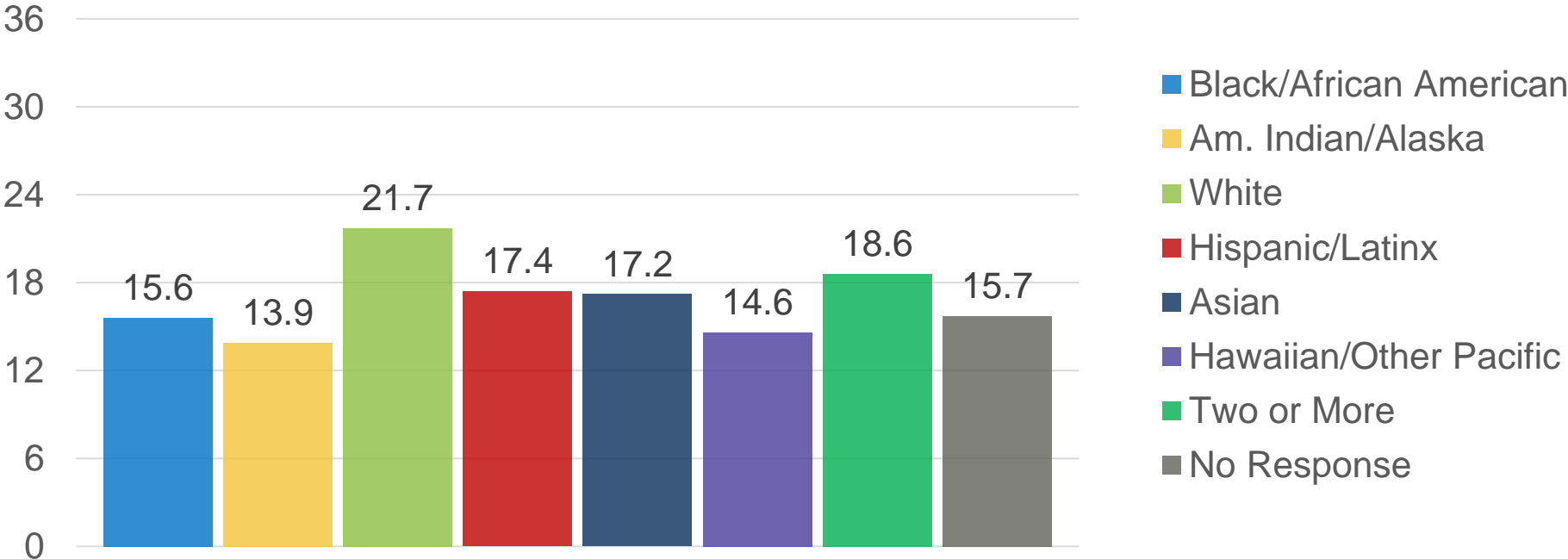
District: 2017 ACT English Scores by Race/Ethnicity



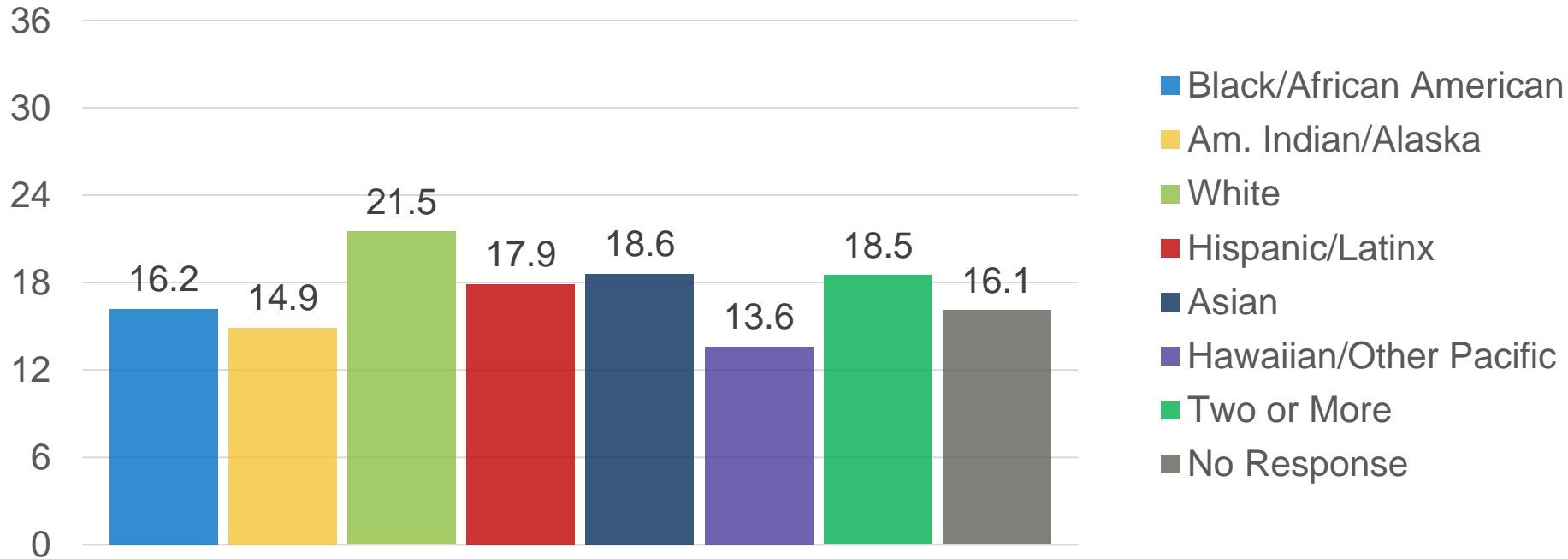
District: 2017 ACT Math Scores by Race/Ethnicity



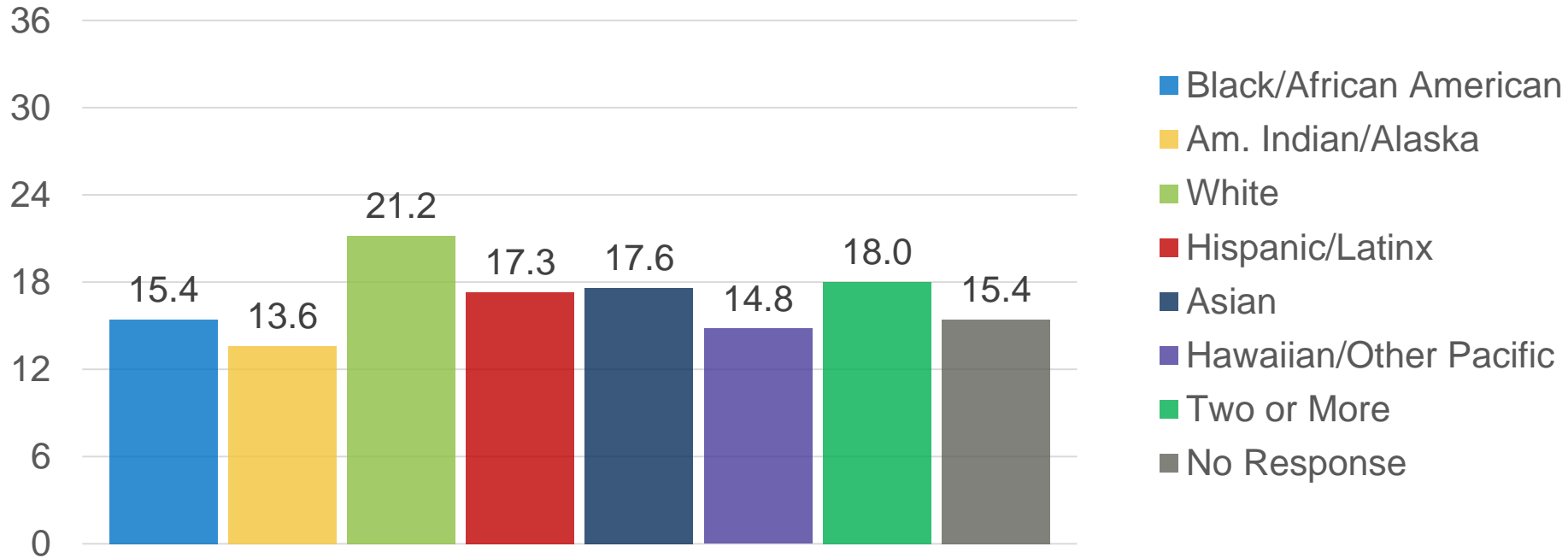
District: 2017 ACT Reading Scores by Race/Ethnicity

District: 2017 ACT Composite Scores by Race/Ethnicity

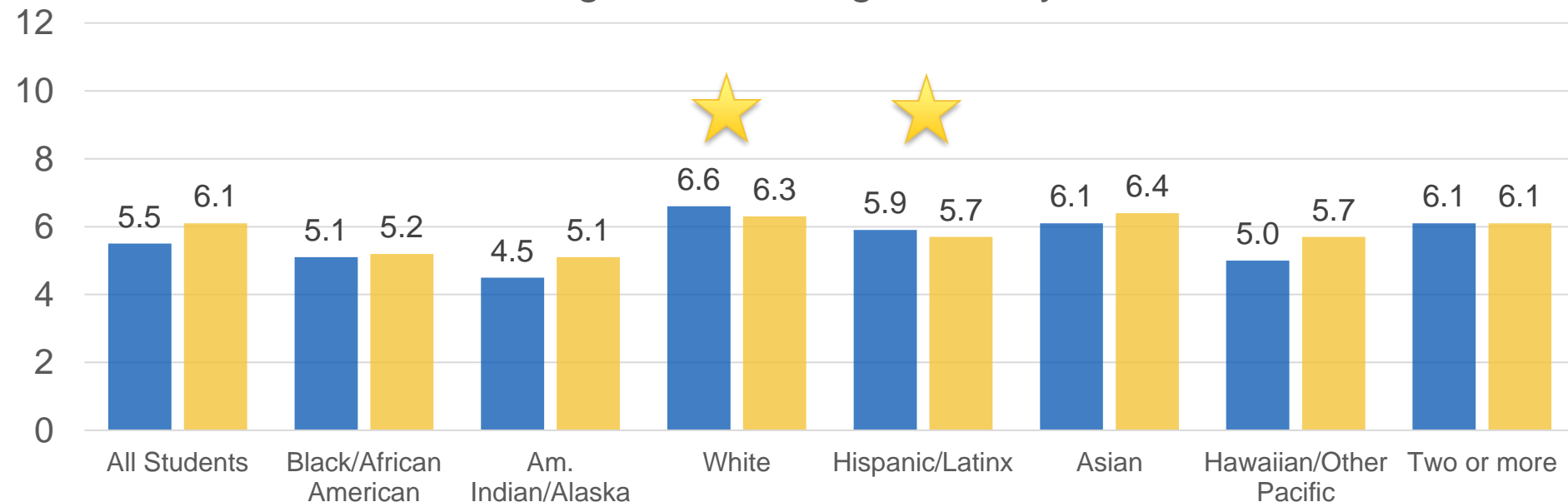


ACT Writing

- Beginning in fall 2016, ACT reports Writing Test scores on a range of 2-12, with 12 being the highest possible score
- The Writing score is the average of the four writing domain scores (Ideas and Analysis, Development and Support, Organization, and Language Use and Conventions) which are also scored on a scale of 2-12
